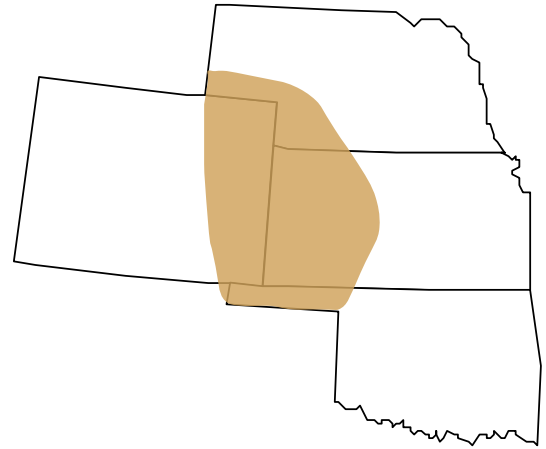

Breck has excellent test weight and lower polyphenol oxidase (PPO), providing opportunities in the Asian noodle market. Breck also offers very good yield, sprouting tolerance and excellent resistance to stripe rust. Certified Seed Only, no saved seed allowed.
