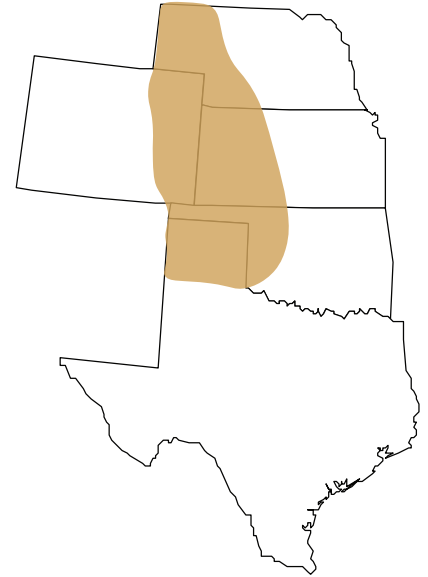

and very good baking quality. Stripe rust resistance and acid soil tolerance are very good, winterhardness and SBMV are excellent. Langin has shown strong adaptation across the High Plains.
